STUDENT QUALIFICATION

All students must be at least a rising freshman in high school to participate. Middle school students (grades 6-8) are not eligible for this program. *Parents are responsible for transportation to and from the camp. NON-PARTICIPANTS ARE NO LONGER ACCEPTED IN THE PROGRAM.*

DATE, TIME & PLACE

Report date for the camp is **Sunday**, **June 21**, **2020 after 12:00 noon**. Participants will be able to check directly into the residential halls after this time. There will be a brief *MANDATORY* orientation at 4:00 p.m. in the band room. The camp will begin on **Monday**, **June 22**, **and end Friday**, **June 26**, **2020**. All participants must checkout of the residential halls by **8:00am on Saturday**, **June 27**, **2020**. The entire camp will be held on the campus of Bethune Cookman University in Daytona Beach, Florida.

COST

The total cost for the Bethune Cookman University Summer Band Camp is \$500.00 per student and \$300.00 per chaperone, director, driver. All personnel attending the camp must complete an application. The fee will include the following:

Instrumentalist are required to wear black shorts-NO GYM SHORTS (at least 18-20" long from waist to knee) and solid black sneakers with black athletic socks. Flag and Dance will receive information on proper attire for the performance. Please be aware that students who do not comply will not be allowed to perform. Flip Flops, house shoes, shower shoes and bedroom shoes are prohibited during camp social events, practices and performances.

CONDUCT

All students are asked to conduct themselves in the appropriate manner during the duration of this camp. Please follow the rules of your school and respect our campus. Students that cannot follow instructions or cause problems for others will be held in the custody of campus police, until arrangements are made, by the parent(s) or band director, for transportation back home.
